The Lebanon City Council will hold public hearings on April 15, 2020, beginning at 7:00 p.m. for the following:

- A. COMMUNITY REVITALIZATION TAX RELIEF APPLICATION: DANA SEGUIN, 4 SOUTH PARK STREET** – Public Hearing for the purpose of receiving public input and taking action on a request by Dana Seguin for re-approval of his April 19, 2017 approval for tax relief under the provisions of the Community Revitalization Tax Relief Incentive Program (NH RSA 79-E).
- B. ORDINANCE #2020-05** – Public Hearing for the purpose of receiving public input and taking action to amend City Code Chapter 68, Fees, Article I, Water Investment Fee, to update and clarify language and to implement a Water Development Fee.
- C. AMEND CAPITAL BUDGET TO INCLUDE SPENCER STREET RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT & APPROPRIATE \$100,000 FOR DESIGN ENGINEERING** – Public Hearing for the purpose of receiving public input and taking action to amend the 2020 Capital Budget in include a project for the reconstruction of Spencer Street; and to appropriate \$100,000 (One Hundred Thousand Dollars) for design engineering for the project. Appropriation will be funded by a transfer of funds from the existing 20 Spencer Street Cleanup Project to the newly created Spencer Street Reconstruction Project.
