**WHEREAS**, Kenneth (Ken) Warren has served as a Member of the City of Lebanon's Pedestrian and Bicyclist Advisory Committee from 1999 through June 4, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, Ken was steadfast in his commitment to public service as a Member of the Pedestrian and Bicyclist Advisory Committee for two decades; being fully dedicated to the duties and responsibilities of a Member, serving in the spirit of wisdom, collaboration, and integrity, and applying professional expertise when he was with the NH Department of Environmental Services then in-kind as a retiree to bear on issues discussed by the Committee; and

**WHEREAS**, Ken, besides being a Member of the Pedestrian and Bicyclist Advisory Committee, served as liaison for the Friends of the Northern Rail Trail in Grafton County, faithfully attending meetings to keep the City informed of issues and projects on the Northern Rail Trail in the Mascoma Valley; and

**WHEREAS**, Ken's knowledge of rail trails and commitment to addressing related infrastructure needs enabled him to report to the City's Department of Public Works when trail mowing or other significant work like drainage improvements were needed.

**WHEREAS**, Ken, garnered innumerable resources to improve the Northern Rail Trail in Lebanon, a key transportation corridor in our community, securing numerous grants to pay for materials for bridge re-decking and ditching work, and working with snowmobile clubs and other volunteers to replace original decking on nine bridges between downtown Lebanon and East Lebanon, at the town line with Enfield; and

**WHEREAS**, Ken, selflessly patrolled the Lebanon portion of the Northern Rail Trail on a regular basis to monitor repair needs, clean up debris and downed trees, often on his own with personal resources; and

**WHEREAS**, Ken, left a legacy and positive impact on everyone who has had the opportunity to work with him and who has benefitted from use of the Northern Rail Trail.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Lebanon City Council, on behalf of the City of Lebanon, extends its sincere appreciation to Ken Warren for his dedicated service and contributions to the community over the past 20 years.
