7. PUBLIC HEARING ITEMS:

7.A – LEBANON / ENFIELD INTERMUNICIPAL AGREEMENT

A public hearing for the purpose of receiving public input and taking action to authorize the City Manager to enter into an Intermunicipal Agreement with the Town of Enfield for the continued provision of wastewater treatment services for Enfield residents/businesses.

The City Council scheduled this public hearing at their October 2, 2019 regular meeting. The public hearing was properly noticed in the *Valley News* on October 5, 2019 in accordance with City Code and State Law.

BACKGROUND

The existing Intermunicipal Agreement between the City of Lebanon and the Town of Enfield has expired. City Administration met with representatives from the Town of Enfield to finalize an updated Intermunicipal Agreement (IMA) that would be in the best interest of our inter-related communities; see included draft and outline of changes.

Following the public hearing, the document will be forwarded to the Attorney General for approval. Agreement will not take effect until it is approved by the Attorney General in accordance with NH RSA 53-A:3.V.

ACTION

The following motion is offered for Council consideration:

MOVED, that the Lebanon City Council authorizes the City Manager to enter into an Intermunicipal Agreement with Town of Enfield for the continued provision of wastewater treatment services for Enfield residents/businesses. The agreement will take effect upon approval by the New Hampshire Attorney General.
