**7.C – MID-GRANT UPATE ON CDBG FOR
HEADREST FEASIBILITY STUDY**

A public hearing is required by CFR 570.486 and RSA 162-L:14 in order to receive public input and apprise Lebanon residents on the progress of the Headrest Feasibility Study.

The City Council scheduled this public hearing at their February 5, 2020 regular meeting. The public hearing was properly noticed in the *Valley News* on February 8, 2020 in accordance with City Code and State Law.

BACKGROUND

In June 2019 the City of Lebanon was awarded a \$12,000 CDBG Feasibility Study grant to evaluate the low-intensity treatment facility at 14 Church Street. This feasibility grant allowed Headrest to employ an architect and energy design specialist to evaluate the 14 Church Street building for programmatic needs and long-term sustainability and energy efficiency; and to determine the cost to bring the facility into line with the needs of the clientele and to ensure that the facility is up to standards for the health and well-being of Headrest's clients. The study was completed in August of 2019, however early reporting provided both cost estimates and preliminary design allowing Headrest to successfully apply for implementation funds in 2019. In November, the NH Community Development Finance Authority awarded the project \$500,000. The project is currently awaiting Governor and Council approval of the funds and is moving ahead with environmental review. Renovations are anticipated to be completed in early 2021 in time for the Headrest 50th anniversary.

Shelley Hadfield of Hadfield Associates will be present to provide the update and answer questions.

ACTION

This public hearing is required by 24 CFR 570.486 and NH RSA 162-L:14 in order to receive public input and advise Lebanon citizens on the progress of the project. No action is required by the Council.
