**9.F – DISCUSSION & SET PUBLIC HEARING FOR JUNE 3, 2020:  
ORDINANCE #2020-08, TO AMEND CITY CODE CHAPTER 68, FEES,  
TO IMPLEMENT A “STORMWATER PERMIT APPLICATION FEE”**

**BACKGROUND**

The amendments to City Code Chapter 124, proposed by Ordinance #2020-07, implements a Stormwater Use Permit and Application Fee. Changes to City Code Chapter 68, as proposed by Ordinance #2020-08 are required to implement the fee associated with the permit.

**ACTION**

**CITY OF LEBANON  
ORDINANCE #2020-08**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND the Code of the City of Lebanon, Chapter 68 FEES, Article III Miscellaneous Fees, Section 68-15 Enumeration of Fees.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Lebanon, as follows:

Section 1

Section 68-15 of Chapter 68, Fees, of the Code of the City of Lebanon is hereby amended to add a new Section (C) "Stormwater Permit Application Fee" to read as follows: revise Chapter 68 FEES, Article III Miscellaneous Fees, Section 68-15 Enumeration of Fees, for the purpose of adding Stormwater Permit Application Fee.

**C. Stormwater Permit Application Fee**

**(a) The fee for a stormwater permit application shall be \$250.**

Section 2. Severability

The provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable, and if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or part thereof is, for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or part of this ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage.
