ARTICLES

Article 02 Operating Budget

To see if the School District will raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling \$47,560,257. Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be \$46,688,828, which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Lebanon School District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only.

Article 03 Authorized Regional Enrollment Agreement (AREA)

To see if the School District will vote to amend the existing Grantham-Lebanon-Plainfield Authorized Regional Enrollment Agreement (AREA Agreement) between the Grantham, Lebanon, and Plainfield School Districts which provides for the continued education of: (A) Grantham's students in grades seven through twelve at Lebanon Middle School and Lebanon High School, and (B) Plainfield's students in grades nine through twelve at Lebanon High School; and, to approve renewal of the AREA Agreement for a term of ten (10) years, to commence on July 1, 2021 and expire on June 30, 2031 in accordance with the proposed AREA Agreement on filed with the District Clerk.

ARTICLES CONTINUED

Article 04 To Add Funds to Lebanon School District Special Education Trust Fund

To see if the School District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$300,000 to be added to the Lebanon School District Special Education Expendable Trust Fund previously established. This sum to come from June 30 fund balance available for transfer on July 1 in excess of \$1,000,000. (The first \$1,000,000 of the June 30 Unassigned Fund Balance will be used to reduce the school tax rate in 2021.) No amount to be raised from taxation.

(Majority Vote Required)

Article 05 To Add Funds to Lebanon School District Construction and Renovations Capital Reserve Fund

To see if the School District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$500,000 to be added to the Lebanon School District Construction and Renovations of School Buildings Capital Reserve Fund previously established. This sum to come from June 30 fund balance available for transfer on July 1 in excess of \$1,000,000. (The first \$1,000,000 of the June 30 Unassigned Fund Balance will be used to reduce the school tax rate in 2021.) No amount to be raised from taxation.

Article 06 Increase Fund Balance Retention

To see if the School District will vote to authorize, indefinitely until specific rescission, the School District to retain any unused portion of the year-end unassigned general funds, from the preceding fiscal year in subsequent years, provided that the total amount of the year-end unassigned general funds does not exceed, in any financial year, 2.5 percent of the current fiscal year's net assessment. The School Board shall hold a public hearing to expending retained general funds.

(Majority vote required)
