- 1. I have read this permit and understand the requirements and conditions this permit imposes. I hereby agree to comply with City of Lebanon Code, Chapters 68, 124 & 136 which state the rules and regulations of the Public Stormwater Usages and understand that lack of compliance could result in termination of drainage connection. By signing this application, I am granting permission to the Engineering Group or Authorized City Employee to enter my property to perform the service which I have requested.
- 2. A plan of the property which accurately shows all existing utilities to include: drainage, sewer, water, underground electric etc.
- 3. A set of plans and specifications related to work
- 4. To accept and abide by all provisions of the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Public Works of the City of Lebanon and of all pertinent Ordinances or Regulations that may be adopted in the future.
- 5. To operate and maintain any pretreatment facilities in an efficientive manner at all times, and at no expense to the City of Lebanon.
- 6. To cooperate, at all times, with the Engineering Group and their representatives in their inspections.
- 7. To notify the Utility Maintenance Group immediately in the event of any accident, negligence, or other occurrence that creates discharge to the public stormwater system of any drainage not covered by this permit.
- 8. To notify the Engineering Group at (603-448-3112) at least 48 hours in advance before the drainage will be ready for inspection and connection to the public stormwater system and to set up an appointment for the inspection.
- 9. An inspection by a City Employee or City Authorized Representative must be completed prior to any portion of the work is covered with soil.
- 10. Notify the contractor installing the stormwater connection of any conditions of this permit.
- 11. A drainage report of the pre and post conditions of the manhole, ditch, catch basin, etc. that is to be connected.
- 12. Tie sheets for connections.
