Dear Resident/Property Owner:

I am writing this letter today to cordially invite you to a neighborhood/corridor meeting to be held on Monday, October 26, 2015 at 5:30pm in Parish Hall at Sacred Heart Church, 2 Hough Street, Lebanon, NH. The meeting is to provide information on the **Mechanic Street Reconstruction Project**.

Some of you may have attended past "walk-about," or one, or both of the previous Community Conversations held on September 10, 2013 and May 27, 2014 where we presented conceptual roadway layouts and discussed sidewalks, drainage issues, intersections, etc. Your comments and input was gathered at all of the meetings and incorporated into the proposed design alternatives. Currently, we are finalizing the Engineering Study in order to move forward with Preliminary Design. Phase I of the project is anticipated to begin in Spring, 2017.

At the meeting on the 26th, we will have representatives from City Staff along with the City's Engineering Consultant, Fay, Spofford and Thorndike (FST) providing an overview of the project and design alternatives. Conceptual Roadway Layouts will be available for viewing. We are looking for your input and concurrence on the City's preferred alternative.

Please keep in mind that we are in the initial stages of design, so there is still a lot of work to be done before finalizing the plans for construction. As you know, Mechanic Street is a major travel route; your input is vital to making this project a success. I encourage you and all of your neighbors to attend. Beyond the residents and businesses located on the corridor, we are inviting and encouraging all residents, and members of City Council to join the conversation, so please spread the word, and we'll see you all on the 26th.
