City Hall, the Green, Whipple Building and the area of the Mall	Vandalism, noise complaints, disturbances, juvenile issues including bullying and loitering.	02/05/17	Ongoing
Wolfe Road - Boulder's Condominiums	This location experiences a high call volume for reports of drug activity, theft, vandalism, burglary and noise complaints. Project resulted in a 47% decrease in drug offenses, 14% decrease in calls for service and a 7% decrease in arrests.	11/17/16	Resolved
Intersection of Main and Bridge St.	Significant drug activity and drug sales, alcohol violations and trespassing on State owned land. Officers liaised with various business owners to increase communication. Officers saturated problem areas at key times for enforcement and an increased presence. The area of the water tower was secured to prevent trespassing and officers continue to monitor that area. Officer continue to monitor the parking lot of the Circle K for loitering, trespassing and disorderly behavior.	11/03/16	Resolved
Mack Avenue	Neighborhood complaints of vehicular and pedestrian traffic from a residence that may be connected to drug activity. Officers saturated the area with uniform and plain clothes personnel. Officers identified possible suspects and subsequently made two arrests for drug possession and drug sales. Individuals involved were not residents and were restricted from returning to the home.	8/24/17	Resolved
