



PROCLAMATION

Refill NOT Landfill Month

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon owns and operates the Lebanon landfill that has a permitted disposal capacity of another 9 years; and

WHEREAS, the City is concerned about conserving natural resources and with preserving the landfill disposal capacity for future Lebanon residents; and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes that the waste from single-use items like plastic water bottles, coffee cups, grocery bags et cetera, uses natural resources and consumes landfill disposal capacity; and

WHEREAS, the City also recognizes that eliminating waste through reuse is cost effective and environmentally beneficial; and


WHEREAS, choosing to reuse items like refillable containers for water, coffee and other beverages have the potential of reducing waste that will require disposal in the Lebanon Landfill; and

WHEREAS, choosing to reuse cloth grocery bags, cloth napkins and packing a lunch for school or work has a positive impact on the environment; and

WHEREAS, to encourage waste reduction, the month of April 2023 will be designated as “Refill NOT Landfill Month”.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Lebanon hereby proclaims the month of April 2023 as Refill NOT Landfill Month and encourages residents to join in observing this month to reduce waste that is ultimately disposed of in the Lebanon Landfill by using reusable items like travel mugs, water bottles, and grocery bags.
