Dear Resident/Property Owner:

As the plans for Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO) Project, Phase 12 reach final design, we would once again like to invite you to participate in a Community Conversation about the project on **Thursday, April 4, 2019 at 5:30PM** in City Hall, Council Chambers, 51 North Park Street, Lebanon, NH. Since the 75% plans were presented in November 2018, there have been some changes to the Mechanic Street portion of the project. These changes will be discussed at the 5:30pm meeting, but for anyone interested, we will also be conducting a site walk beginning at **3:00pm** in front of Jake's Coffee Shop.

Representatives from the City's Department of Public Works and consultant Wright-Pierce will be present to give a short overview of the design of the streets within the CSO #12 area (Freeman Ave, Myra Ave, Avon Ave, Ora Ave, Mascoma Street, Bomhower St, Mechanic St, Terrace View Condo's.) The plans to be presented are at the 100 percent design level and are a combination of engineering infrastructure improvements and the concerns, ideas, and suggestions received at the neighborhood walks in June and the 75% design meeting last November.

Ninety Percent (90%) project plans are available on the City's website, and hard copies are available for viewing at the Department of Public Works, 193 Dartmouth College Highway, Lebanon. The project is set to go out to bid in May. <https://lebanonnh.gov/DocumentCenter/View/9114/CSO-12-90-Plans>.

Public participation is always encouraged and appreciated. We hope that you and your neighbors will attend the meeting(s) on April 4th as your input is very important and highly desired as we work to finalize the plans for construction.
