Re: Lebanon Landfill No Longer Accepting Construction and Demolition Waste


The City of Lebanon is currently evaluating options for extending the useable “life” of the Lebanon Landfill for future disposal needs. We are in the midst of completing a business plan that will be presented to the City Council this summer. As we work to understand the lifespan of the landfill, we are faced with the realization of the potential need to divert material from the landfill to increase its longevity. In measuring the materials currently disposed of, nearly 20% of total waste consists of construction and demolition (C&D) debris, defined as: dimensional lumber, plywood, wood waste, railroad ties, roofing material, shingles, sheetrock, brick, concrete, flooring material, insulation, tiles, and siding.

With a focus to extend the disposal capacity of the Lebanon landfill, **AS OF MAY 1, 2019**, and until further notice, the Lebanon Solid Waste Facility will discontinue the acceptance of C&D waste. We are cognizant of the hardship that this may create for some and thank you in advance for your understanding. Options for disposal of C&D in the region include: The Town of Hartford Recycling Center, 2590 North Hartland Road, Hartford, VT (802-295-3622); Casella Waste Services Transfer Station, 40 North Labombard Road, Lebanon, NH (603-838-3472); and Hammond's Grinding and Recycling, 11 Hammonds Way, Canaan, NH (603-523-4353). We have made all three of these facilities aware of the discontinuance, so they may be prepared for an influx of customers & waste.

As we plan for the life of the landfill, City staff will be researching alternatives to managing C&D and how the City of Lebanon can best continue to provide a full-service solid waste facility while preserving future disposal capacity. We welcome your input!
